Memorandum Two of Plaintiff

The Plaintiff Informs the High Court and the Debtors of the Following

1. That the Debtors had until five pm on third day of April 2024 to pay the plaintiff the sum of one (\$182,481,438.00NZ) or the plaintiff had the lawful right to add further charges as outlined on invoice and Commercial Lien Notice and Admiralty Statement of Claim being eighty billion dollars where the claimant has added the charges for every man woman or child to date that has had a severe reverse reaction or died from being co-erced or lied to. The claimant has provided evidence of her compensation schedule of one-million-dollar charge of for any harm to any man, woman and child in her land being the land of New Zealand. The plaintiff confirms that no payment was received by the due date.
2. The updated invoice as the third and final demand notice is attached with the full amount charged to the individual debtors and the corporation with the amount being eighty billion, one hundred and eighty two million four hundred and eighty one thousand four hundred and thirty eight new zealand dollars (\$80,182,481,438.00NZ) where the Debtors have a further ten working days until five pm on eighteenth day of April in the year of 2024 to provide a signed affidavit of defence of every single debtor with evidence or with immediate effect from 5pm on 18th day of April the claimant will step in and take possession of the corporation and its assets until paid in full or remain in charge until paid out in full.
3. The Plaintiff and Claimant is Janine of the House of Arabella and Walters who is the authorised representative of Janine ARABELLA, also known as Janine WALTERS. Janine is the Secured Party and holds Power of Attorney of the trade names Janine ARABELLA and Janine WALTERS but is not surety to them as debtor.
4. The Plaintiff and Claimant has provided a provisional list in memorandum two of the assets of the individuals and the corporations being three hundred and forty two properties of the corporation and four properties of the individuals plus the staff contracts of approximately two hundred and twenty thousand staff according to internet plus equipment and fleet vehicles. The provisional total only comes to thirty two billion dollars and it is determined that the individuals and the corporation does not have sufficient assets to pay out the Claimant, so the only option presented is for full seizure and possession and control of the assets and the corporation.
5. That the Plaintiff and Claimant had four of the individual debtors served personally where the fifth debtor Scott Hart denied his identity, then hid behind a locked door so was not able to serve the documents. As a result the Plaintiff removed the debtor due to not having managed to serve the documents personally, but in event of full takeover will address the liability and responsibility of this debtor separately. The serving documents were included with memorandum two.
6. The Plaintiff and Claimant has been informed of a recent tragic death of close family member of debtor Debra East and due to the fact the evidence so far presented has

- only shown minor involvement of this debtor, so the plaintiff has chosen to remove Debra East as being a debtor and will remove her name from the asset list, so as not to cause her any extra stress as this time and no longer required to provide an affidavit of defence.
7. That the Plaintiff and Claimant also chooses to remove Don Sorrenson's home from the list of assets as evidence at this time only shows that he was involved in breaching of rights and terminating two to three staff members at the time of the mandates.
 8. The full accountability remain on the two debtors Peter Chandler as the previous Chief Executive Officer of the Bay of Plenty District Health plus Margie Apa the current Chief Executive Officer where evidence shows breaching of rights of many thousands of individuals, implementing of vaccine roll out and mandates where liability remains in place for every death and severe adverse reaction plus all cover ups to prevent any liability, plus falsifying of documents to increase number of covid deaths, where the debtors knew that the vaccine was not safe or effective prior to the roll out, plus cover ups to do with knowledge of excessive deaths, plus ongoing use of drug remdesivir or its generic equivalent to treat covid which has a high death rate associated with using this drug, plus the harm caused to the claimant with loss of her daughter while under the legal care of the district health board with cover ups of her death, plus loss of employment and her livelihood plus psychological harm plus discrimination.
 9. The Plaintiff and Claimant has the intention of operating the corporation as the new commander of the ship/corporation with the goal to restore justice and accountability for actions resulting in harm so that the individuals involved have to make amends for his/her actions plus returning the unalienable rights of every individual man and woman living in New Zealand having the ability to manage their own affairs and right to make informed choices over how they manage their health and every aspect of life.
 10. The plaintiff has also claimed All Rights Reserved so in the event of any honest mistakes or errors or omissions has the right to correct these.
 11. The Debtor's lawyer representing them Chris Jury has stated that he wishes to receive court documents electronically to chris.jury@tewhatauora.govt.nz with first receipt of Admiralty Statement of Claim on Monday 18 March 2024 with the hard copy received by courier post on Tuesday 19 March at 6.30am, and first receipt of Memorandum One being 25 March 2024 and first day of receipt of Memorandum Two being fourth day of April 2024 with last day for defence being 5pm on Thursday the eighteenth day of April 2024.
 12. The lawyer Chris Jury representing Health New Zealand and the individual debtors was requested to provide a copy of the high court documents to all the debtors and gave no clear indication that he had done this, so each of the individual debtors had the high court documents served to him or her with evidence of the times and dates of the serving attached to memorandum two. Chris Jury was required to confirm in writing that he has distributed a copy of Memorandum Two to all the debtors, and he has not responded, so the Plaintiff has sent them copies of memorandum two and three.

Dear Debra

I have just heard about the recent loss of your only son. I am so sorry for your loss and that the serving of documents I believe came on the day of his funeral – that was terrible timing and if I had been informed the day would have changed.

I want to assure you that I have no intention of claiming your home. You had been appointed as the central spokes person on behalf of the defendants and then communication stopped and no one informed me that you were no longer in this role. I am not sure what the truth is as when the deponent came to the hospital to serve you the documents someone said that you left working there a long time ago, so documents were served at your home address. My last direct communication with you was in January 2024.

While you are going through this terrible time of grief and pain I do not want to add to it, so know your home and employment are secure and that any actions by yourself that have been dishonouring or in breach of the rights of others for implementing the mandates and addressing others like me who were terminated there are ways that you can be involved in remedying this to fully restore your integrity and credibility.

After this is over, I hope one day to sit down with you as two mothers who have both lost children before their time and hear about your wonderful son.

I am removing your name as a debtor so you no longer are required to put up a defence.

Thinking of you at this time. Please see court memorandum attached for your knowledge.

YOUR UNALIENABLE RIGHTS

30 Basic Human Rights List | Universal Declaration of Human Rights

List of 30 basic human rights. Human rights is moral principles or norms that describe certain standards of human behaviour, and are regularly protected as legal rights in municipal and international law. These were voted in by United Nations General Assembly at the Palais de Chaillot in Paris, France on 10 December 1948.

This declaration consists of 30 articles affirming an individual's rights. Those 30 articles currently known as 30 universal declaration of human rights or 30 basic human rights, including rights to life, rights to education, rights to organize and rights to treated fair among others things. The 30 universal human rights also cover up freedom of opinion, expression, thought and religion.

30 Basic Human Rights List

1. **All human beings are free and equal** All human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights. They are endowed with reason and conscience and should act towards one another in a spirit of brotherhood.
2. **No discrimination** Everyone is entitled to all the rights and freedoms, without distinction of any kind, such as race, colour, sex, language, religion, political or other opinion, national or social origin, property, birth or other status. Furthermore, no distinction shall be made on the basis of the political, jurisdictional or international status of the country or territory to which a person belongs.
3. **Right to life** Everyone has the right to life, liberty and security of person.
4. **No slavery** No one shall be held in slavery or servitude; slavery and the slave trade shall be prohibited in all their forms.
5. **No torture and inhuman treatment** No one shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment.
6. **Same right to use law** Everyone has the right to recognition everywhere as a person before the law.
7. **Equal before the law** All are equal before the law and are entitled without any discrimination to equal protection of the law. All are entitled to equal protection against any discrimination in violation and against any incitement to such discrimination.
8. **Right to treated fair by court** Everyone has the right to an effective remedy by the competent national tribunals for acts violating the fundamental rights granted him by the constitution or by law.
9. **No unfair detainment** No one shall be subjected to arbitrary arrest, detention or exile.
10. **Right to trial** Everyone is entitled in full equality to a fair and public hearing by an independent and impartial tribunal, in the determination of his rights and obligations and of any criminal charge against him.
11. **Innocent until proved guilty** Everyone charged with a penal offence has the right to be presumed innocent until proved guilty according to law in a public trial at which he has had all the guarantees necessary for his defence. No one shall be held guilty of any penal offence on account of any act or omission which did not constitute a penal offence, under national or international law, at the time when it was committed.
12. **Right to privacy** No one shall be subjected to arbitrary interference with his privacy, family, home or correspondence, nor to attacks upon his honour and reputation. Everyone has the right to the protection of the law against such interference or attacks.

13. **Freedom to movement and residence** Everyone has the right to freedom of movement and residence within the borders of each state. Everyone has the right to leave any country, including his own, and to return to his country.
14. **Right to asylum** Everyone has the right to seek and to enjoy in other countries asylum from persecution. This right may not be invoked in the case of prosecutions genuinely arising from non-political crimes or from acts contrary to the purposes and principles of the United Nations.
15. **Right to nationality** Everyone has the right to a nationality. No one shall be arbitrarily deprived of his nationality nor denied the right to change his nationality
16. **Rights to marry and have family** Men and women of full age, without any limitation due to race, nationality or religion, have the right to marry and to found a family. They are entitled to equal rights as to marriage, during marriage and at its dissolution. Marriage shall be entered into only with the free and full consent of the intending spouses. The family is the natural and fundamental group unit of society and is entitled to protection by society and the State.
17. **Right to own things** Everyone has the right to own property alone as well as in association with others. No one shall be arbitrarily deprived of his property.
18. **Freedom of thought and religion** Everyone has the right to freedom of thought, conscience and religion; this right includes freedom to change his religion or belief, and freedom, either alone or in community with others and in public or private, to manifest his religion or belief in teaching, practice, worship and observance.
19. **Freedom of opinion and expression** Everyone has the right to freedom of opinion and expression; this right includes freedom to hold opinions without interference and to seek, receive and impart information and ideas through any media and regardless of frontiers.
20. **Right to assemble** Everyone has the right to freedom of peaceful assembly and association. No one may be compelled to belong to an association.
21. **Right to democracy** Everyone has the right to take part in the government of his country, directly or through freely chosen representatives. Everyone has the right of equal access to public service in his country.
22. **Right to social security** Everyone, as a member of society, has the right to social security and is entitled to realization, through national effort and international co-operation and in accordance with the organization and resources of each State, of the economic, social and cultural rights indispensable for his dignity and the free development of his personality.
23. **Right to work** Everyone has the right to work, to free choice of employment, to just and favourable conditions of work and to protection against unemployment. Everyone, without any discrimination, has the right to equal pay for equal work. Everyone has the right to form and to join trade unions for the protection of his interests.
24. **Right to rest and holiday** Everyone has the right to rest and leisure, including reasonable limitation of working hours and periodic holidays with pay.
25. **Right of social service** Everyone has the right to a standard of living adequate for the health and well-being of himself and of his family, including food, clothing, housing and medical care and necessary social services, and the right to security in the event of unemployment, sickness, disability, widowhood, old age or other lack of livelihood in circumstances beyond his control. Motherhood and childhood are entitled to special care and assistance. All children shall enjoy the same social protection.

- 26. **Right to education** Everyone has the right to education. Education shall be free, at least in the elementary and fundamental stages. Elementary education shall be compulsory. Technical and professional education shall be made generally available and higher education shall be equally accessible to all on the basis of merit.
 - 27. **Right of cultural and art** Everyone has the right freely to participate in the cultural life of the community, to enjoy the arts and to share in scientific advancement and its benefits. Everyone has the right to the protection of the moral and material interests resulting from any scientific, literary or artistic production of which he is the author.
 - 28. **Freedom around the world** Everyone is entitled to a social and international order in which the rights and freedoms set forth in this Declaration can be fully realized.
 - 29. **Subject to law** Everyone has duties to the community in which alone the free and full development of his personality is possible. In the exercise of his rights and freedoms, everyone shall be **subject only to such limitations as are determined by law solely for the purpose of securing due recognition and respect for the rights and freedoms of others** and of meeting the just requirements of morality, public order and the general welfare in a democratic society.
 - 30. **Human rights can't be taken away** Nothing in this Declaration may be interpreted as implying for any State, group or person any right to engage in any activity or to perform any act aimed at the destruction of any of the rights and freedoms set forth herein.
- So those are all Universal Declaration of Human Rights list by United Nations General Assembly. All universal human rights list above commonly known as 30 basic human rights that must be respected and protected by the law.
