girls and boys. A gift of much needed stationery supplies brought great joy and excitement, says Taylor. "It was as if Christmas had come again."

The group stopped at the graveside of veteran Mercy Sister Cyril who spent years working in Pawarenga and who is buried next to St Gabriel's Church there. Her great-niece, Stephanie Hamlin, laid flowers and read a prayer. "And once again, we chorused together with another waiata," says Taylor.

The long journey back to the marae ended with a candlelit dinner, because of a power failure. "It was interesting, to say the least, for 150 girls to eat, shower and get ready for bed in the dark," Tessa recalls.

"But we managed without too many casualties. An impromptu concert, lit by cell phones, lifted our spirits before bed."

A poroporoaki or farewell ended the marae stay, with another blessing from Pa Tate and some final words of wisdom. "We left with a sense of togetherness," says Taylor.

"We gained a richer appreciation for tikanga Maori, and for the synchronicity between Maori spirituality and our Catholic faith."

One of the last stops on the hiko was at Waitangi, where the famous Treaty was signed in 1840. "We could almost feel the presence of those who had gathered there all those years ago," says Tessa.

"It seemed an appropriate way to end our trip, at the place where the history of our united nation began."

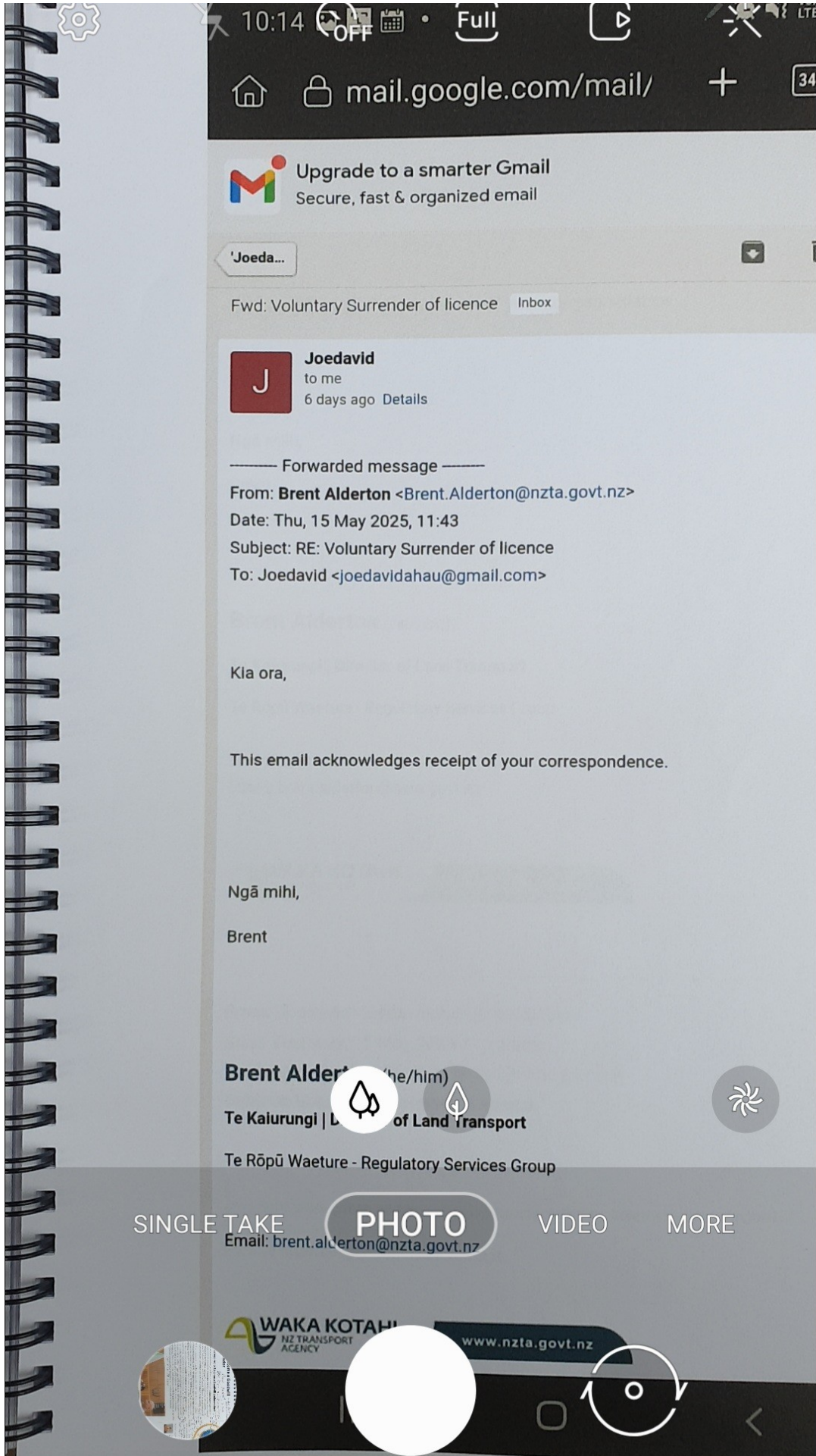



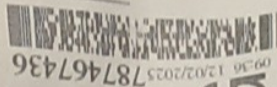

# Application to cancel registration Important information

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TA agent.  
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2. You must present ID to the agent.

- Acceptable ID for an individual is:
  - a New Zealand driver licence, or
  - any combination of documents showing name, date of birth and signature.
- Acceptable ID for an incorporated company is:
  - an NZTA customer number, or
  - evidence of your NZBN, or
  - a certificate of incorporation.

3. Remove the plates from the vehicle so you can return them with your application. If you don't return the plates you may not be entitled to a refund of licensing fees.

4. Apply to cancel the vehicle at an agent. Take your application form, ID, the plates and the administration fee to a registration agent for processing. To check the administration fees go to [www.nzta.govt.nz/cancel-registration-fee](http://www.nzta.govt.nz/cancel-registration-fee)

If the motor vehicle's licence has already expired you'll also be required to pay licence fees from the date the licence expired up to the date of cancellation. If you can't pay these at the time, NZTA will post a payment demand to you for these fees shortly after cancellation.

Follow these steps to cancel the registration:

- Fill out an *Application to cancel registration* form (MR15). You'll need to select one of the following reasons for cancellation. The vehicle:
  - has become permanently useless as a motor vehicle, or
  - is destroyed and will never be able to go back on the road, or
  - is written off by an insurer, or
  - is removed permanently from New Zealand.

You can't cancel the registration if:

- the vehicle has been stolen and not recovered. You should notify the NZ Police, and then call us on 0800 108 809.
- the plates were lost or stolen. You should complete an *Application for replacement plate* form (MR6A) instead.
- you're not the registered person for the vehicle. Only the registered person can cancel a vehicle's registration.
- you only want to replace the registration or personalised plates.
- you've found the plates and are only handing them in. The agent will take the appropriate action.
- you've sold the vehicle and the buyer hasn't notified NZTA. See *Buying and selling* (Factsheet 41) for more information.
- you're temporarily taking the vehicle off the road. See *Vehicle licensing* (Factsheet 49) for more information.

## What happens next?

Once your application has been processed the Motor Vehicle Register will be updated and the registration cancelled. Refunds of any unused portion of a licence must be approved by NZTA and can't be issued by the registration agent.

## Refunds

We may refund you any unexpired licence fees paid (the licence transaction fee is non-refundable). Any refund is liable for audit and is at the discretion of NZTA. You must return the plates to get a refund.

If your vehicle has been in a fire or accident and the plates can't be recovered, you'll need to get a letter from the police or fire service confirming this. If your vehicle was destroyed or dismantled by a wrecker, you'll need to get a letter from the wrecker confirming this.

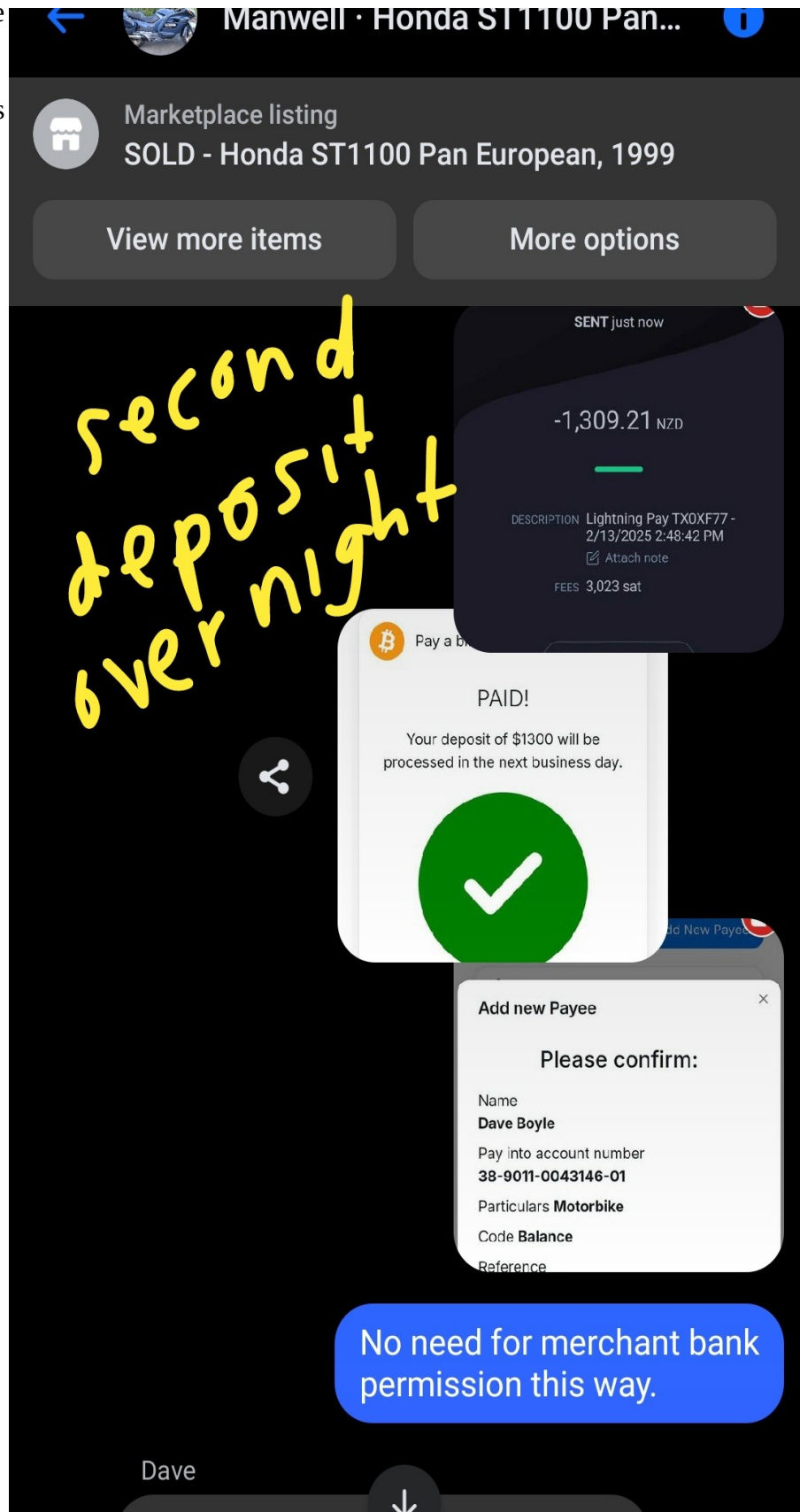

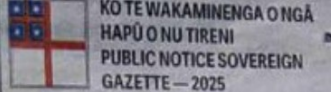

**DECLARATION OF AUTHORITY**

This Notice records that Te wakaminenga o Ngā Hapu o Nu Tirenī  
 convened in Congress Assembled on 16-27 October 2025 under  
 Tikanga taki iho.

Te wakaminenga exists only when sitting in Congress Assembled with  
 the uri tohu rangatira hapu kai māngai present and acting collectively,  
 and all authority derives solely from this collective mandate.

**CONSTITUTIONAL FOUNDATION**

Tikanga is the original constitutional and territorial law (lex situs) of  
 Nu Tirenī.

Te Kara 1834 affirms the international legal personality of the hapu. He  
 Wakaputanga 1835 confirms the sovereign independence of Nu Tirenī.  
 No lawful cession of sovereignty ever occurred. The sovereign  
 authority of Nu Tirenī remained with Te wakaminenga o Ngā Hapu,  
 whose independence was affirmed internationally in 1835 and  
 reaffirmed through the 1840 Aukati and Nullification declarations. The  
 later signatures of kaitiaki settlers could not alter or extinguish hapu  
 sovereignty, and the Treaty processes were constitutionally incapable  
 of transferring authority that the Crown never lawfully acquired. The  
 entire nation never ceded sovereignty.

**HISTORICAL RECORD**

Archival evidence held within the Te Kara Registry, British Crown files,  
 and U.S. Consular Papers confirms that Te wakaminenga remained  
 the pre-existing constitutional authority in 1840.

British assertions of sovereignty were disputed and unperfected in  
 law, contrary to governing imperial statutes: the Murders Abroad Act  
 1817, New South Wales Act 1823, Australian Courts Act 1828, the Victoria  
 instruments of 1839-1840 limiting authority to British subjects,  
 and s 7 of the Pacific Islanders Protection Act 1875 preserving Uri

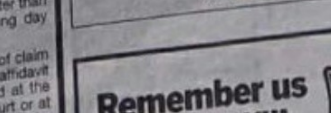
